

### Rural Campus Setting

A high performance school is under construction at Spaulding Youth Center in Northfield, NH, scheduled to be completed in the spring of 2012. Surrounded by gardens, landscaping and playgrounds, the new school



is sited to take full advantage of the beautiful fields and woods and spectacular mountain vistas on our 470 acre

hilltop campus. Spaulding's rural campus offers a safe, supportive and natural living environment for children and youth ages 5-20.




### More Day Students

This thoughtfully designed new center of learning will help meet the increasing demand for high quality special education programs and services for children and youth with a range of challenges including autism, neurological impairments, behavioral difficulties and emotional, learning and developmental disabilities.

The new school at Spaulding is designed to accommodate an additional 36 students, once added capacity is approved by NH DOE, up from the current limit of 64, thus opening up ***needed space for more day students.***

## New School Features

The 21,856 square-foot, energy-efficient high performance school includes:

- 10 large academic classrooms, acoustically sound, each with natural lighting and restrooms
- Each classroom equipped with interactive whiteboards
- A larger classroom to accommodate kindergarten-aged children
- Physical, occupational and speech therapy rooms
- Independent Living Skills suite with full kitchen
- Multi-Purpose science room
- Media Center/Library with state-of-the-art technology
- Health Services station
- Town Square and Atrium
- Academic offices and conference and meeting rooms



## Academic Program

Spaulding's NH DOE Bureau of Special Education-approved school offers year-round comprehensive educational services for students in grades K-8 with emotional and behavioral disorders and girls and boys from age 5-20 with autism or neurobehavioral disorders. The school curriculum covers all core subjects and features educational enrichment through the arts and outdoor education programs, physical education and wellness. Youth 14 and over receive vocational education and job skills training. All students receive services outlined in their Individual Education Plan (IEP) which may include speech, language, occupational, and physical therapy, independent living skills and community integration activities.
